The five apartments have been conceptually designed so that all rooms are accessible and handicapped accessible. The apartments are located in a residential area, which is within walking distance of the city center. Each flat has a modern designed nursing bed, creating a sense of security and to feel comfortable.

Sankt Georgen in the Black Forest is located in the center of many culturally valuable cities, which are all easily accessible by train or bus. The station is 1.5 km away from the residential area and can be easily reached by bus or taxi. It is also possible to arrange an individual travel service via the Auszeit team. They can also transport people in wheelchairs, for example.

In consultation with "Ferienland im Schwarzwald GmbH", the holiday and leisure facilities are also individually discussed in advance and planned, but can be adapted on-site at any time. Again, all employees of both teams are available at all times. We constantly strive to improve our offer and adapt it to the needs of our guests and prospected persons. Therefore, the holidays of each guest are intensively evaluated.
