






AMT Concept is a non-profit association in the Brussels Capital Region whose objective is to develop any action aimed at improving the accessibility of public spaces, transport and the built environment.



For any kind of travel, people need exhaustive information on the state of the infrastructure.


A step, a badly calculated door width, a wrongly placed plant can be sources of dependence and weariness for disabled travelers or their travelling assistants.
