- 800 years old Hanseatic City (1218)
- Located in North East Germany
- Directly by the Baltic Sea
- 208.000 inhabitants
- 600 years old university with 15.000 students

- Visitors get acoustic experience of 380 species
- "Darwineum" exhibition offers fossils to touch

- 15 km from Rostock city centre
- Barrier-free promenade and pier
- Disabled parking
- Barrier-free beach ramps and beach chairs
- Rental of bathing wheelchairs
- Maritime Events all year

- Largest coastal forest in Germany
- Cycling and hand-cycling region
- Special climate of forest and sea air
- Positive effect on health and activities
- Climate supports thalasso therapies







#### **Events: Hanse Sail**

- Traditional maritime festival
- 2nd weekend in August every year
- 1 million visitors
- Accessible event area at city harbour
- Sign language interpreter for the opening
- Tactile plans for blind visitors







#### **Events: ROSTOCK CRUISE FESTIVAL**

- Takes place every two years
- Next edition: September 2020
- Focusing on the cruise industry
- Cruise parade with 3 ships
- Big fireworks
- Barrier-free festival area at Cruise Terminal

- Voted best German accessible hotel 2015
- Accessible floors, restaurant and conference rooms
- Wheelchair-accessible rooms
- Disabled and non-disabled working staff







#### Certification

- 2 certified Tourist information centers in Rostock city and Warnemünde
- Certified according to the German labelling system "Travelling for all"
- Criteria e.g.: accessible entrances, paths, shelves, counters, seating areas, information


